Journey21's Summer Academy is a uniquely designed, three-week program held Monday through Friday for individuals ages 15 and older with intellectual or developmental disabilities (IDD).

The curriculum emphasizes life and independent living skills, creative learning, and engaging community outings – all within a welcoming, supportive environment where students are encouraged to grow, connect, and make the most of their summer.

From engaging morning activities to exciting field trips, every day offers new opportunities to build confidence, strengthen independence, and form lasting friendships.

Each Summer Academy session combines structured learning with hands-on fun, fostering creativity, building confidence, and encouraging meaningful connections.

- Art, cooking, and group projects, inspiring imagination, collaboration, and a sense of accomplishment

- Experiencing exciting community adventures to Camp Whitcomb, the Milwaukee County Zoo, Summerfest, State Fair, American Family Field, and more




## 2026 SUMMER ACADEMY SESSIONS
